
# **Graphical Analysis**





3 such rashan drives were held in which more than 600 families were provided rashan bags. These rashan bags contained enough quantity to support a small family for whole month's rashan needs.






widespread power breakdowns and electricity crisis that has grappled the country, this step to convert to an unlimited source of energy has put the University into quite a favourable position.




